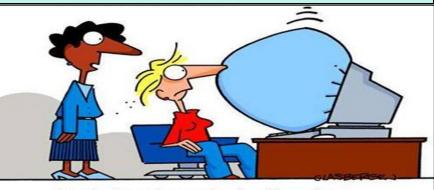

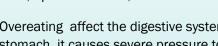

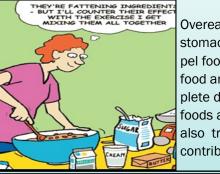
HOLIDAY INDULGENCES LEADS TO
